<u>Winter Tax Bills</u> are due on or before <u>February 14, 2024</u> without interest/penalty. I will be available at the township hall from 9:00 am-5:00 pm to accept payments on 12/29/23 & 2/29/24. Cash payment <u>must</u> be exact change.

Treasurer's office hours are 9am - 5pm; Monday thru Friday; excluding holidays.

Payments are <u>NOT</u> accepted at my residence. Please mail or come to the hall. As of this writing we do not have a drop box available at the hall for payment 24/7.

Credit Card payment can be made. Please email for further information. There is a 3% convenience fee added to the total to be processed.

Postmarks are not accepted as date paid. Payments are receipted on date received.

If you require proof of delivery, please do not require my signature. I have a full-time job and cannot be available to sign for or go to the post office to pick up. I suggest Priority Mail.

You can combine multiple parcels on one check. Please make sure to have receipts or correctly noted parcel numbers. If I cannot figure out where to apply, I will send it back for clarification.

- **DO NOT** staple, paperclip or in any way attach items together.
- **DO NOT** send postdated checks. These will be automatically returned. I cannot <u>"loan"</u> you time for processing nor <u>"hold"</u> your check.

I am <u>NOT</u> responsible for lost mail. Please send me an email to the address below if you wish to check status.

As of 2/15/2024 interest and penalties will be applied to all outstanding winter taxes.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL KRAKOW TOWNSHIP VOTERS

<u>RE</u>: 9-Day Early-Voting

A Municipal Agreement was signed by the Townships of Krakow, Posen, Pulawski and Metz to establish the early voting site at the POSEN COMMUNITY CENTER, 10813 Michigan Avenue, Posen, Michigan. Dates and hours will be posted on the website, krakowtownship.org, and published in <u>The Presque Isle County</u> <u>Advance</u>. Election information is always available at the Michigan Voter Information Center, Michigan.gov/vote. 2024 Elections will be held in February, August and November. Absentee ballots will be handled by the clerk and voting on Election Day will be at the Krakow Township Hall, 12022 Bolton Road, Posen.

Township official's 4-year terms expire on November 20, 2024. Supervisor, clerk, treasurer and trustees (2) will be on the August and November ballots. Nominating petitions will be available by contacting the clerk.

Your Absent Voter Ballot Application will offer you the option of receiving YOUR BALLOT automatically for each future election for which you are eligible. You will be responsible for keeping your yearly mailing address/addresses current so your ballot will be mailed to the correct address. All voters have a constitutional right to state-funded prepaid return postage on absent voter applications and ballots. <u>ZONING ADMINISTRATOR</u>

ZONING PERMITS: No building may be constructed, altered, enlarged upon, or moved without a Township Zoning Permit. This permit is required before the County Building and Zoning Department will issue a building permit. Contact your Zoning Administrator, Arthur Lewandowski, at 989-255-8129 for information and/or zoning permit application forms or visit the township website www.krakowtownship.org.

BUILDING INSPECTOR: Once you have obtained a township zoning permit, you must also obtain a building permit by contacting the Presque Isle County Building inspector, Ken Robb, @ 989-734-2915 for an application form. pibuild@picounty.org

Forms can also be obtained from your Township Zoning Administrator.

RECYCLING STATION: Your recycling can still be brought to the location. Please feel free to walk in your recycling. We have moved the bins closer to the gate to assist you with this. This is a county run program. Contact Michael Darga 989-734-7219 or John Chappa 989-766-2738 with questions.

STREET LIGHTS: Report any township street light outages to the Township Supervisor or Clerk as soon as possible. Do not hesitate to report any unusual activity around the township hall, street lights, or the recycle station to a township official. Repairs due to vandalism are billed to the township, and continuous incidents at a specific light may result in a decision by the Township Board to discontinue future repairs to it.

MEETINGS: All meetings are held at the township hall at 12022 Bolton Rd. in Posen

Board of Trustees: Monthly, on the second Tuesday of each month at 7:00 pm.

Planning Commission: Quarterly@ 7:00 pm. on the 4th Thursday of the month and on an as needed basis.

Rezoning and Special Use permit requests will be heard on dates and times agreed upon by the Planning Commission Chairperson. A fee will be charged to applicants for a hearing.

Zoning Board of Appeals: Meet annually for organization, and as needed to hear appeals.

Contact the Zoning Administrator for details. A fee will be charged to applicants for a hearing. Board of Review: July, December and March of each year. Call the Supervisor for dates and times or visit our website. Meeting and Public Hearing changes and cancellations: Notice is posted at the township hall and/or published in a local
